The wind ensemble will feature: Karla Flygare, Flute; Jennifer Nelson, Clarinet; Mona Butler, Bassoon, and Rodger Burnett, French horn

These musicians are all principal players with both the Auburn Symphony and Pacific Northwest Ballet orchestras. They will be accompanied by Dianne Chilgren at the piano. Ms. Chilgren is a piano soloist for the Pacific Northwest Ballet. Robert Hutchinson, whose wind quintet will have its world premiere that afternoon, is an Associate Professor of Music Theory and Composition at the University of Puget Sound in Tacoma.
